From the stone columns, to the *eucaliptos* (eucalyptus) posts/beams and recycled concrete roof tile on the caretakers apartment, we are making every effort to recreate a campus that feels very Ecuadorian. The mechanical and structural systems, however, will be modern, offering the best of both worlds.
